Dear Parent or Carer,

Following confirmation from the Prime Minister, we are delighted to confirm that the Willenhall EACT Academy will be able to begin re-opening from 8th March 2021. It goes without saying that we are very much looking forward to welcoming all our students back for face to face teaching and learning later this term. I am very grateful to everyone for their perseverance and support over these last two months.

As you would expect, the DfE has issued full and detailed guidance, some of which requires new but minor actions and preparations in advance of our opening. In order to ensure that our re-opening is as safe and efficient as possible, we intend to draw up a reopening plan and schedule which we will share with everyone by March 2nd 2021.

There is a need for us to invite all students for a series of voluntary Lateral Flow tests prior to their full return. This will require us to implement a phased return for all students during the week beginning March 8th 2021. More details will be shared with you by March 2nd 2021.
