Year 7 – Make students **aware** of careers

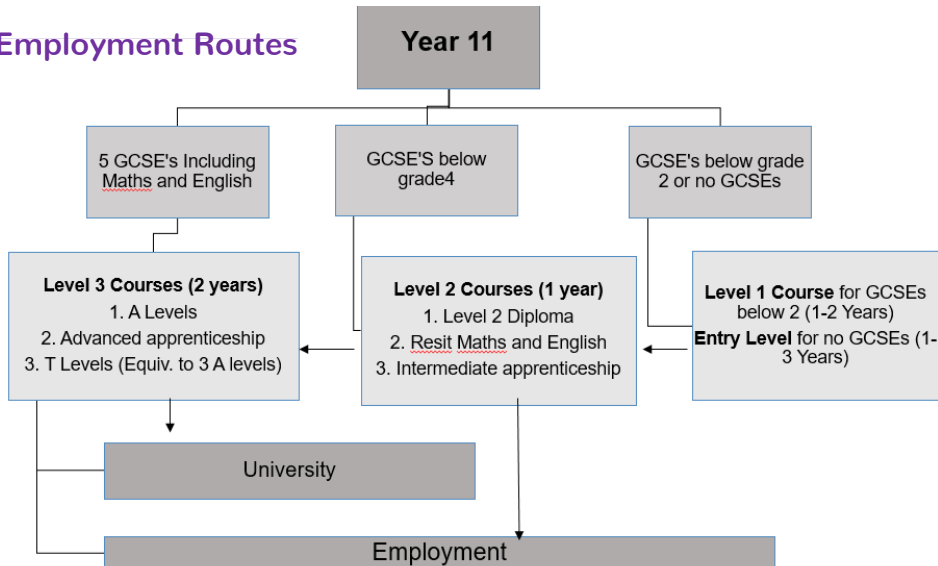
Year 8 – **Prepare** students to build skills and experience needed after High School

Year 11 – Help students **decide** next steps after the Academy

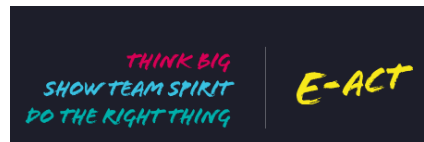
Employment Routes
